Summary:

Ministerial Directives

Overall there is an excellent level of documented compliance with Ministerial Directives. It was noted that the Manager of Security Services does not have police officer status yet supervises a work force that does.

Training

At the time of the review all training was current with the exception of the compliance with training on emergency vehicle operation and motor vehicle pursuit training. Security Officers operate marked vehicles with full emergency equipment both on and off campus in the city of Charlottetown but are not trained in motor vehicle pursuit or the operation of an emergency vehicles. This puts the officers and public at risk and creates liability issues for the officers and UPEI. This issues has been noted in past reviews and not been acted on.

Identification Cards

Officers are carrying their identification cards for production on demand as required.

Recommendation:

That immediate steps be taken by UPEI to provide proper training in motor vehicle pursuit and emergency vehicle operation
